### SCRIPTURE

Read Hebrews 10:4-14

### DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Jesus struggled in the Garden of Gethsemane to do the will of the Father and yet prayed, "thy will be done." What can we learn from him?
2. What have you learned about God's will for you in praying your dangerous prayer?
3. Where are you in the dangerous prayer? Has your desire been met? Are you still waiting? Or do you feel like you got an answer of no?
4. What is your next step with your dangerous prayer?
5. Hebrews 10:14 says, "For by one offering he has made perfect forever those who are being consecrated." How has the dangerous prayer series helped you consecrate your life to God?

### Deeper Dive

1. Jesus accomplished his greatest work when he laid down his will to the Father's will. What are the implications of this for us?
2. When is a time you struggled to do God's will because it was different from what you wanted to do? What did you learn in the process?
